Anand College of Pharmacy organized GUEST LECTURE SERIES-2 on "Industry-Academic Interaction: Bridging the Gap" on 25th March, 2017

A GUEST LECTURE SERIES-2 on **"Industry-Academic Interaction: Bridging the Gap"** was organized at Anand College of Pharmacy, SGI, Agra, on 25thMarch, 2017.

The eminent speakers from Pharmaceutical and Health care Industry delivered talks on the theme of "Industry-Academic Interaction: Bridging the Gap".

In first session, **Dr. Akshay R. Koli**, Senior Manager, Sun Pharmaceutical Industries Ltd., Vadodara delivered a talk on the topic **"Industry-academic partnership for quality culture with some case studies"**. Dr. Koli shared his experience of industry regarding dissolution of tablets and capsules. He emphasized on In India regulations need to be stricter for domestic medicines compared to regulations for export medicines. The results should be more reproducible and data integrity is important for better results. The second lecture of **Mr. Arun. Rawat**, managing director, Kanha Biogenetics Ltd. was on the topic **"Empowering youth through entrepreneurship"**. He called attention to the importance of proper document and records maintenance to reproduce the results as well as for the traceability of any kind of error in process. He conveyed that the rate of growth in the nation is 7.5% but in pharma sector is 15-20% therefore pharmacy is the best career option in future. Third lecture of **Mr. Amit Sharma**, General Manager-Hollioake Pharmaceutical Ltd. spoke on the topic **'Career opportunities in Pharma Marketing'**. He highlighted the need to improve the knowledge of pharmacology and medicinal chemistry in our pharmacists. - Nitank Agarwal (B.Pharm, 3rd year) and Dimple parashar (B.Pharm, 2nd year) selected for anchoring the event.




