## WORLD PHARMACIST DAY CELEBRATION

Students of Anand College of Pharmacy (SGI) celebrated "World Pharmacist Day" on 25<sup>th</sup> September, 2017 with poster presentations, slogan writing competition, rangoli making competition and Powerpoint presentation competition along with Awareness rally. "From research to health care: Your pharmacist is at your service" is the theme of this year's World Pharmacists Day.

In First morning session, Students expressed their creative ideas through posters, slogans and rangoli making. Awareness campaign /rally was organized to create awareness for *swine flu* and *Dengue* in nearby village Lohakarera, Runakta. In this Awareness campaign, Faculty Coordinators Mrs. Priyanka Srivastava, Dr. Mukesh Kumawat, Mr. Gurvinder Pal Singh and Mr. Anuj Srivastava joined the students. Awareness rally started from SUN LORDS PUBLIC School. In this campaign students give information that dengue fever is a disease caused by a family of viruses that are transmitted by mosquitoes. Symptoms of dengue fever include severe joint and muscle pain, swollen lymph nodes, headache, fever, exhaustion, and rash. The presence of fever, rash, and headache (the "dengue triad") is characteristic of dengue fever. Swine flu is a respiratory disease caused by influenza viruses that infect the respiratory tract of pigs and result in a barking cough, decreased appetite, nasal secretions, fever (100° F or greater) fatigue, and headache; the virus can be transmitted to humans. Swine flu viruses may mutate (change) so that they are easily transmissible among human.

In Second session, Powerpoint presentation competition was organized in Radhakrishnan Hall (B.Pharm Hall). **Dr. Kashmira J. Gohil**, Dean, Anand College of Pharmacy addressed the audience and congratulated all for honoring World Pharmacist Day. She also motivated students and staff to keep actively participating in such events to create awareness through Campaigns. Topics for Powerpoint presentation competition were Dengue, Cancer, Japanese Encephalitis, Ovarian Cyst and Career in Pharmacy. The students explained causes, symptoms, diagnosis and treatment of above mentioned diseases.

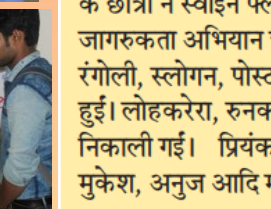
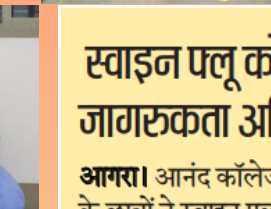
