- ❑ The complete cultural program was well organized

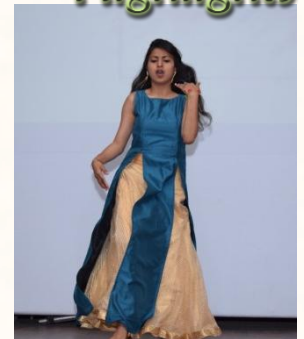
by the efforts of Kartik Singhal and Manali Gupta. It was an emotional occasion with many Final Year students reminiscing about the good times they had spent in the institution.

A Guest Lecture in **Anand College of Pharmacy** was held on **10th April 2018** by **Ms. Sweta Bharadwaj (Trainer and Counselor)**, a principal consultant from Learning Links foundation, *Educational Testing Service(ETS)*, Gurgaon, in Radhakrishnan Hall. She emphasized on how to prepare for studying abroad like Europe, America and Australia. If students are applying for a graduate-level degree, especially a master’s programs, MBA, doctoral programs, awarding fellowship etc, they may be required to submit scores from one or more standardized **graduate admissions tests**. These are internationally delivered tests (GRE and TOEFL) which aim to ensure applicants are prepared for the rigors of advanced study, in their own country or abroad. **Dr. Kashmira J Gohil (Dean, ACP)** motivated students for the awareness regarding competitive tests and encouraged audience for the better interaction. The guest speaker emphasized how CSIR is transforming lives through Research and Innovation. CSIR-IITR initiates on predictive toxicology and risk assessment using the vast knowledge base in the areas of biomarker development, alternative to animal models, mathematical modeling, detection and development methods for pharmaceuticals/toxins/adulterants and environmental chemicals. They also work on new chemical entities, engineered nano materials and genetically modified products on living systems for the development of new technologies. He also motivated students for joining short term courses at CSIR.

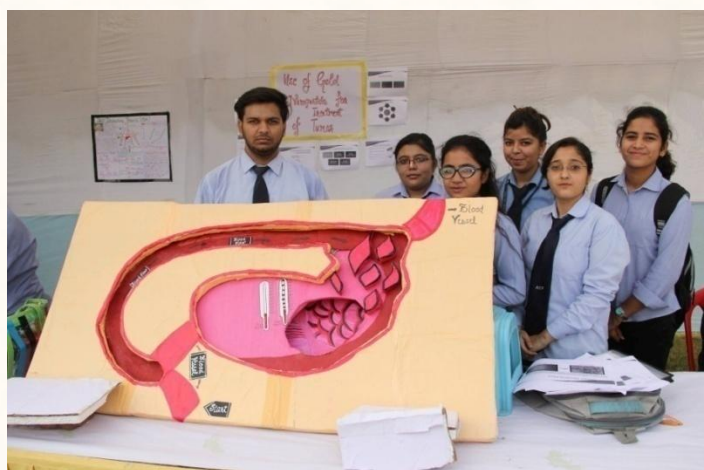


INNOVATION DAY 2017

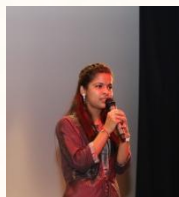
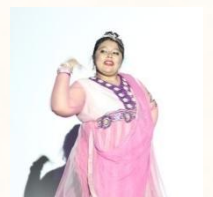
