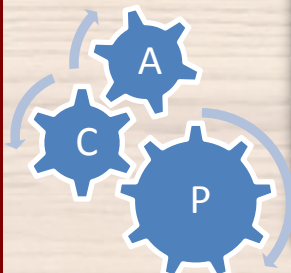

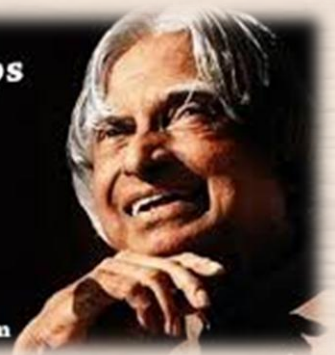

Dr. Kashmira J. Gohil (Dean, ACP) delivered an invited talk in three day International Conference on role of Genetic, Epigenetic, Environment, Nutrition towards Plant, Animal and Human Health (GEENPAHH-2019) from 22<sup>nd</sup> to 24<sup>th</sup> February 2019 organized by the Department of Biotechnology, Hindustan College of Science and Technology, Mathura, U.P. The topic of the talk delivered was: **Pharmacovigilance program of India (PvPI): need of the hour for human health & well being.** The detection, assessment and reporting of hitherto unknown adverse drug reactions (ADRs) have become an urgent need of the hour today. The task of the reporting of individual case safety reports (ICSRs) related to ADR still remains very challenging for India. Epidemiological data supports the existence of specific factors including age, gender, pharmacogenetics and polymorphism that increase the risk of general ADRs. Underreporting of the ADR is the perennially chronic problem in India and worldwide. We need to take more proactive steps to improve the scenario to ensure the safety of the burgeoning population with the diverse systems of alternative therapies prevalent among the masses in the country. The pharmacovigilance of herbal medicines poses the unique challenge and the safety concerns in this area become even more important. What we need is a robust and standardized system of pharmacovigilance in the country to tackle the problem at hand. Reporting and effective management are the urgent needs of the hour today. The talk was well received by audience comprising of international delegates from various countries including Canada, France and Australia, apart from India. Dr. K. J. Gohil also welcomed and presented the mementos to the international guests in the event.



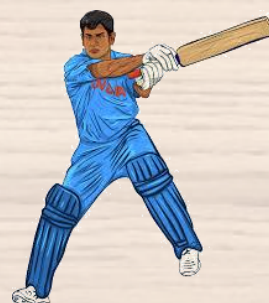

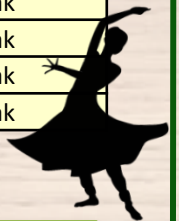


## ACP participation in "CEREBRUM-2019"

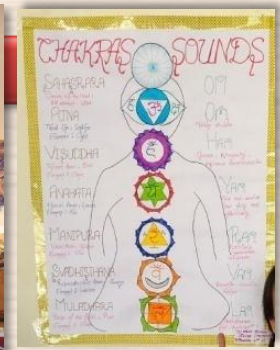
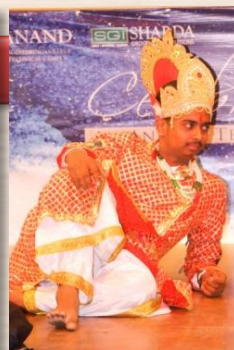
