FRESHER'S WELCOME PARTY-2021:






World Photography Day


WORLD HUMANITARIAN DAY

All the senior faculties gave the message of obedience, discipline, sincerity, hard work towards course work along with extracurricular activities for the holistic development to all students.



The national conference was very informative to all the students of pharmacy & related branches of Health Sciences.






Webinar on the Occasion of Gynecological Cancer Awareness
