INVITED TALK AND INTERNATIONAL COLLABORATION AT UNIVERSITY OF MANITOBA, WINNIPEG, CANADA

Prof. (Dr.) Kashmira J. Gohil, Dean, ACP, SGI delivered an invited talk as a keynote speaker and visiting scientist from abroad at University of Manitoba, Winnipeg, Canada for the seminar series for 'food for thought'.

Prof. (Dr.) Kashmira J. Gohil, Dean, Anand College of Pharmacy, Agra delivered an invited talk on "The potential of specific herbs in promoting health and wellness" as the keynote speaker at the St. Boniface Hospital Research Centre (SBRC) and the Canadian Centre for Agri-Food Research in Health and Medicine (CCARM), University of Manitoba, Winnipeg, Manitoba, Canada on 24 August 2023, followed by the 2nd talk on Drug Safety Aspects, ADR, and Pharmacovigilance as invited by Dean, Pharmacy, at University of Manitoba, on the same day in another session. During her talks, Prof. Gohil emphasized the rich history of two specific herbs in traditional medicine systems and highlighted the latest research on these herbal plants with modern scientific validations and their potential applications, while the 2nd lecture enlightened on the drug safety aspects, various ADR and current Pharmacovigilance system worldwide.

Both the talk were very well received with an active Q&A session to the satisfaction of all international delegates followed by an excellent interaction with fraternity during her visit to their state of the art facilities at hospital research center and college of Pharmacy at international campus. Dr. Gohil immensely enjoyed her interaction with all post-doc and PhD students over their varied queries and interesting discussion that ensued afterward. Dr. Gohil extended sincere thanks to the distinguished **Prof. Dr. N. S. WEBINAR ON MEDICAL CODING WITH AFITECH, BANGALORE ON SEPTEMBER 13' 2022

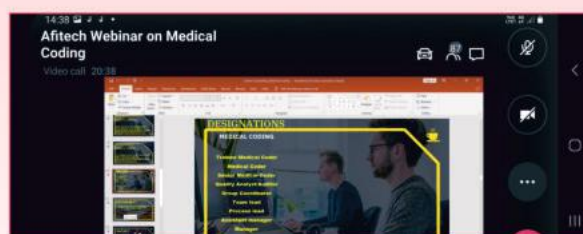
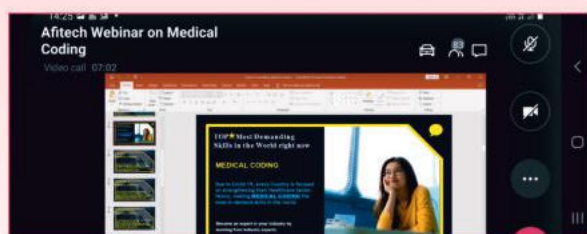

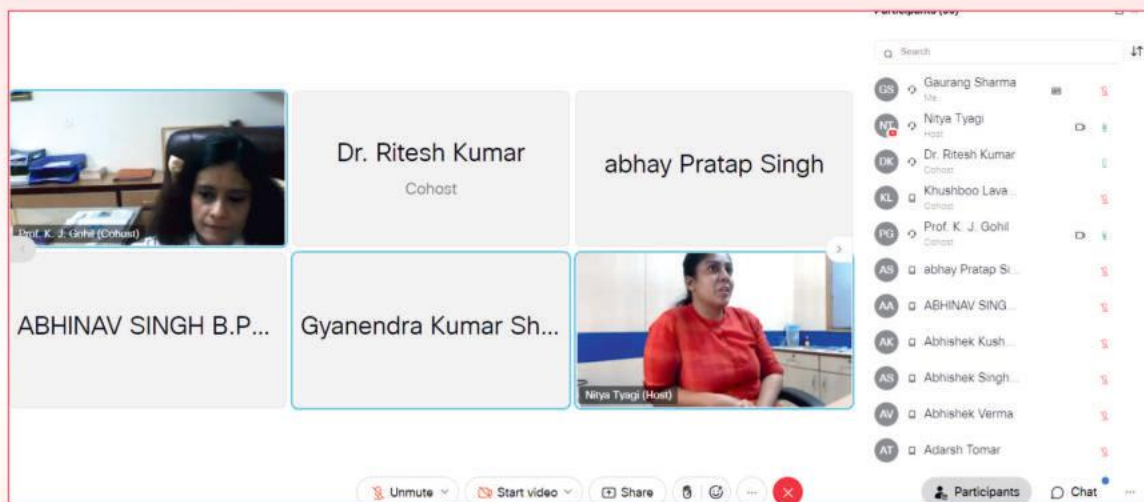
ONLINE LECTURE UNDER IMPACT LECTURE SERIES SESSION BY IIC
